ENVELOPE FOR REQUESTS AND  
CANCELED BALLOTS

1. This envelope is used when a voter completes a request to cancel his/her mail ballot at the polling place on election day.
2. The election judge shall write "canceled" on the returned ballot and place the request and ballot in this envelope.
3. If the request to cancel a ballot does not comply, the election judge writes denied on the request and places the request in this envelope.
4. Place this envelope in Ballot Box No. 4 before delivering the ballot box to the general custodian of records.

## ENVELOPE CONTENTS

- Request to Cancel Ballot by Mail Form, completed by voter and signed by Election Judge
- Democratic Party Ballot to be Canceled, returned by voter (if there were any)
- Register of Surrendered Ballots by Mail (if there were any)
- Poll Pad ticket for voters who changed parties - a voter who canceled the Democratic Party ballot and replaced it with a Republican Party ballot

**If a voter cancels a Democratic Primary Ballot and wants a Republican Primary Ballot, note this on the Register of Surrendered Ballots by Mail form and on the Request to Cancel Ballot by Mail Form.**
