Measure	Description
Mabank ISD Dissolution of Cedar Creek Hospital District	Created years ago, never implemented, needs vote to dissolve. It does have \$50K of funds, will be given as scholarships. Sample Ballot with Cedar Creek and ESD No 1. Measures
ESD No 1 – Authority to adopt a Sales & Use Tax	Grand Saline area Sample Ballot with Cedar Creek and ESD No 1. Measures
ESD No 2 –Authority to adopt a Sales & Use Tax	Whitton area/Martins Mill area Sample Ballot with ESD No 2. Measure
WP ISD Bond	Issue and sell bonds for \$69.9M to be used to renovate, upgrade, acquire, equip school facilities Sample Ballot with WP ISD Bond Measure
Eustace ISD	Ratify the ad valorem tax rate of \$.9469. This is a tax increase. Sample Ballot with Eustace ISD Ad Valorem Tax Rate Measure

Prop 1 – Texas State Technical College Funding	Capital improvement investments in Texas State Technical Colleges for building repair and improvements, equipment.	SJR 59	☒	☒
Prop 2 – No Capital Gains Tax	Texas does not have this now. Prevents a future attempt to tax profits from gains on investments. Protects the wealthy.	SJR 18	☒	☒
Prop 3 – Denying Bail for Certain Crimes	Hands too much power to the criminal justice system, although it is stated as public safety to allow judges to deny bail for certain people accused of serious crimes	SJR 5	☒	☒
Prop 4 – Dedicated Water Fund	Directs \$1B per year to Texas Water Fund, funded by sales and use tax, to improve infrastructure	HJR 7	☒	☒
Prop 5 – Exempt Animal Feed from Ad Valorem Taxes	Helps small ag businesses.	HJR 99	☒	☐ ☒
Prop 6 – Ban Stock Trade Tax	Bans Texas from taxing security trades. Protects the wealthy	HJR 4	☒	☒
Prop 7 – Property Tax Break for Surviving Spouses of Veterans	Property tax relief for surviving spouse of veterans who died from service-related conditions	HJR 133	☒	☒
Prop 8 – Ban Estate and Gift Taxes	Texas currently does not do this. Locks in a permanent ban, protecting the wealthy	HJR 2	☒	☒
Prop 9 – Business Equipment Tax Exemption	Exempts \$125K of business equipment or tools from property tax. Helps small businesses, but possible that it could be exploited by agribusinesses, large corporations	HJR 1	☐	☐ ☒
Prop 10 – Property Tax Relief After Home Fire	Gives homeowners a temporary exemption from property tax on a home destroyed by fire.	SJR 84	☐ ☒	☐ ☒
Prop 11 – Increased School Tax Break for Elderly and Disabled.	Increases school property tax exemption from \$10K to \$60K	SJR 85	☒	☒
Prop 12 – Judge Oversight Changes	Could be weaponized against progressive judges, but worded to appear to promote accountability	SJR 27	☒	☒
Prop 13 – Increased School Tax Break for All Homeowners	Raises school homestead exemption from \$100K to \$140K State promises to backfill school funding. Wealthy benefit disproportionately, but benefits all homeowners.	SJR 2	☒	☒
Prop 14 – Dementia Research Institute	Create publicly funded research institute for dementia and related diseases. \$3B dedicated to funding	SJR 3	☒	☒
Prop 15 – “Parental Rights” Amendment	Trojan horse for enshrining parental rights language into the Constitution, could be used to ban books, silence teachers – “nurture and protect” parental rights could be conditioned on government’s definition	SJR 34	☒	☒
Prop 16 – Citizenship Requirement to Vote	Voting in Texas is already limited to US citizens. This amendment does nothing, undermines election integrity and stokes xenophobia.	SJR 37	☒	☒
Prop 17 – Border Security Tax Exemption	Allows exempt landowners in border counties from property taxes on their security infrastructure, such as fences, walls, cameras	HJR 34	☒	☒
